

BROCKWELL LIDO WALL

Knitted square using stranded work and slipped stitch

Designed by **Pat Gordon-Smith** for the project [Knitting Up Dulwich Road](#)



Materials

- Rowan Felted Tweed, shades Barn Red (196), Carbon (159), Rose Quartz (206) & Peach (212)
- Rowan Cotton Glacé, shade Oyster (730)
- 1 pair 2.75mm knitting needles

Tension 29 stitches & 32 rows = 10 cm

Finished size 18 x 18cm / 7 x 7 inches

Note

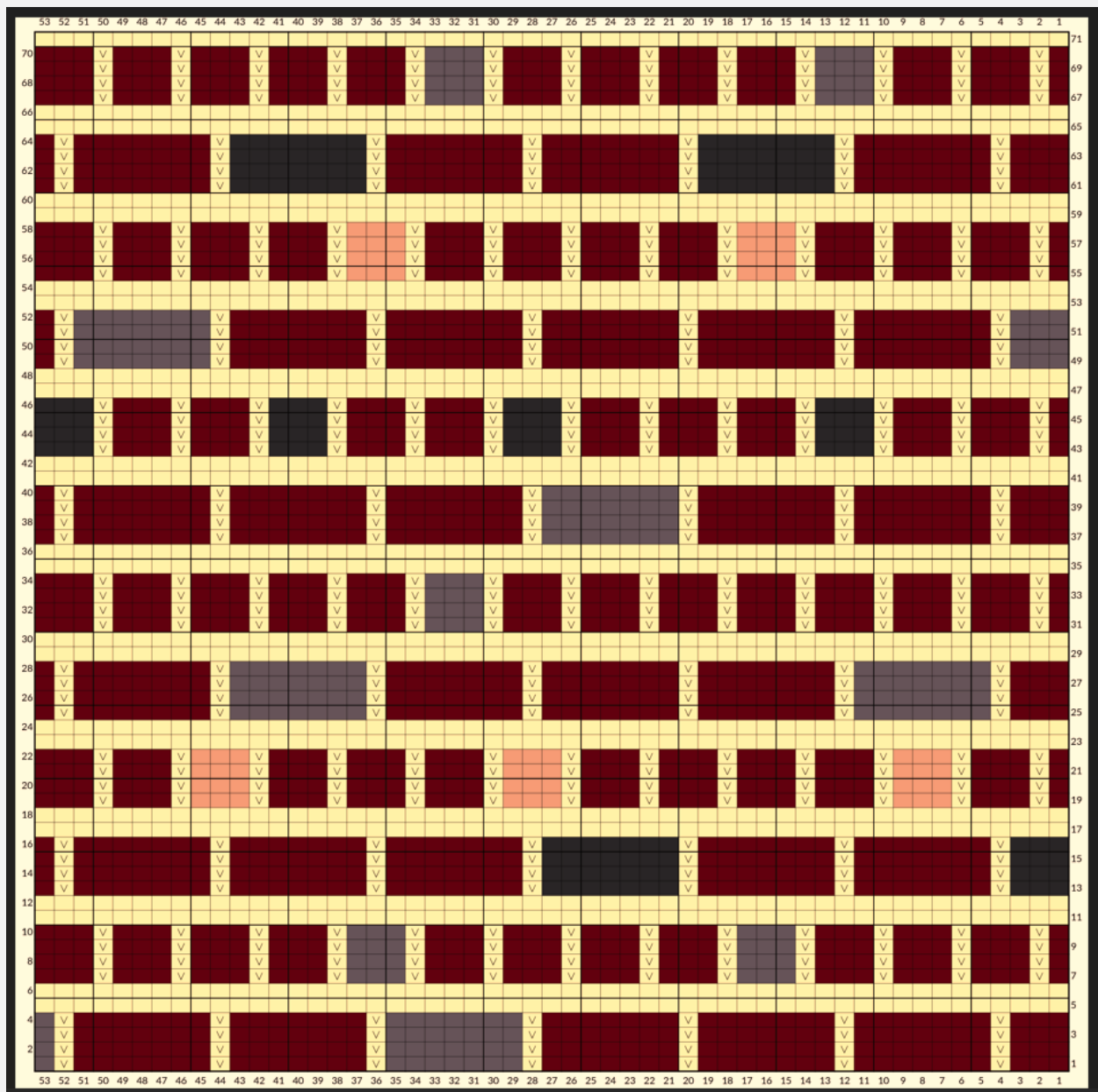
Carry Barn Red and Oyster up the side of the work. Cut off other shades of Felted Tweed at the end of a brick row if they are not used in the next one.

Instructions

- Cast on 53 stitches using Oyster
- **Next row** purl to end
- **Rows 1-71** Follow chart on p.2. My apologies for the very small row and stitch numbers on the chart. Each mortar stripe is 2 rows deep, each coloured block is 4 rows, the small coloured blocks are 3 stitches wide and the large ones are 7 stitches wide
- With WS facing, cast off stitches purlwise
